Deep garnet-purple in color, the 2012 Directors' Cut Cabernet Sauvignon is profoundly scented of ripe blackcurrants, licorice and eucalyptus with hints of choco-mint and cloves. Full-bodied and laden with minted cassis flavors, it has a medium level of rounded tannins, crisp acid and a finish that has a great length if a little straightforward.

Soft, succulently fruited, swimming in toasty, cedary oak but the fruit is up to it. Blackcurrant and eucalypt and plenty of both. Fine-grained tannin. Bang on. Drink 2015 - 2024
